One way to understand range (like Covid and typhoon/storm warnings) is to color code it: red is bad, orange is getting bad, yellow is sort of bad. The charts below show the lists of color-coded synonyms for bad taste, offensive, violation, trespass, insult, displeasure, anger, hard feelings.<sup>2</sup> Optically, we are all tuned to recognize and react to these colors. What stood out for me is the different lengths of the lists.

Colors matter. Yellow is a particularly troublesome metaphor ... it can get racist like "the yellow peril" to describe Chinese immigration to the US starting the 19th century. Or, for Mandarin speakers, yellow describes all things pornographic. I also learned what I thought is a friendly color like blue is actually explained as "transnational organized crime at sea," And, o course, much is spun about black and the infamous brown. A popular phrase now is "people of color," which I noticed As Americans using for themselves: I don't remember being included as such when I lived in the US.
